A member of our church volunteered at the border recently in a shelter that houses immigrants released by ICE in care of a sponsor but are waiting for the sponsor to send money for transportation. Each person is supposed to get one change of clothes, but the donated clothing has few items for children. Also, the clothes donated for adults are usually too large for Hispanic people.

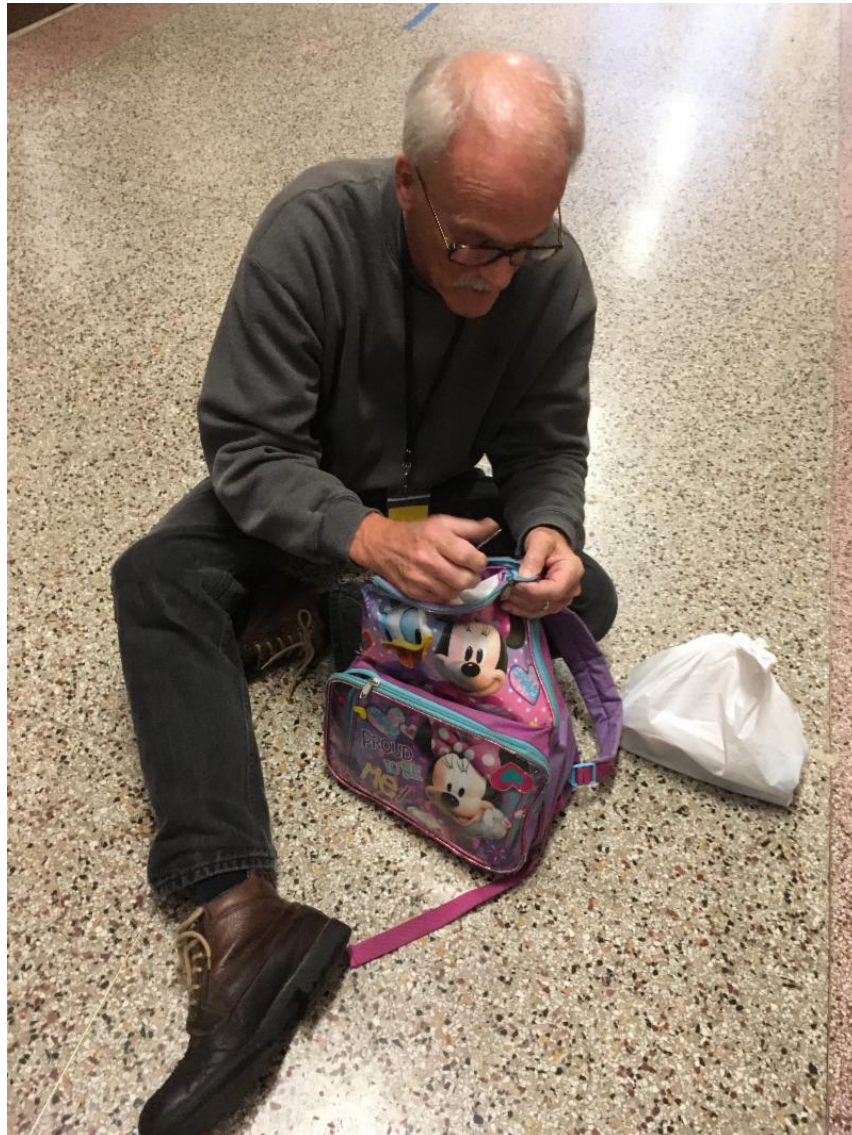
Living Table will collect clothes for children (and in sizes petite small or medium for adults) on Easter and the week afterward. Although people may be going to warm climates, they travel on an air conditioned bus or

airplane. Thus, sweaters, sweatshirts, and jackets are needed, as well as long pants and long-sleeved shirts. Underwear, tights, and shoe laces are sought-after items. Cash is appreciated. We will also need some money for shipping the clothing to El Paso.
